The objective of the Society is to advance the education of the public in the practice, appreciation and use of all forms of calligraphy and lettering arts.

When you access a website small text files, known as cookies, are automatically stored on your electronic device. These cookies are like a little 'memory' for the website so that it can recognise you when you come back and respond accordingly: cookies are used to store your user preferences and purchase information.

If you want to disable cookies you can do so by accessing your browser's help page and following the on-screen instructions. You will still be able to access our sales and membership renewal pages. Payment through those pages are handled by PayPal and direct debits by GoCardless and are therefore subject to the PayPal and GoCardless Privacy Policies, respectively.

For analytics purposes Google Analytics uses cookies to store information, such as what time your current visit occurred, whether you have been to the site before, and what site referred you to the web page. These cookies contain no personally identifiable information but they will use your computer's IP address to know from where in the world you are accessing the Internet.
